Items Discussed:

- 1) Treasurer's Report—There is currently \$4692.17 in the account.
- 2) Bottle Drive—Tentative dates are 9/23/06 or 10/7/06.
- 3) Ice Cream Social—Preferred date is 6/8/06 at 6:30 PM in the Baker cafeteria. Tina will check on the availability of the Baker cafeteria for that date. The alternate date will be 6/22/06. Jackie Caselle is the Chairperson for this event. Byrne Dairy is donating 3 containers of ice cream with the purchase of one. Jackie ordered vanilla, chocolate, cookie dough and holy cow.
