Cleveland Heights Hockey League (CHHL) Summer Camp

Mid-Aug.

Weeklong hockey day camp at Heights with experienced instructors, plenty of ice time, off-ice instruction, other activities, and lunch provided.

Registration for CHHL Travel Hockey

Mid-Aug.

Sign up in person or by fax or mail. Forms will be available in advance. Teams play in the Cleveland Suburban Hockey League in the following divisions: Mite (ages 6–8), Squirt (9–10), Pee Wee (11–12), Bantam (13–14). Heights will field multiple teams per division, depending on the number of players registered. Players will be assigned to teams based on ability.

CHHL Player Evaluation Sessions

Late Aug.

Three or four sessions per division spread over two weeks. This is the chance for coaches to get to know the players and assign them to teams that will best fit their experience and abilities.

Preseason, Cleveland Suburban Hockey League

Early Sep. to mid-Oct.

Practices, skill sessions, and games to (a) help players prepare for the coming season and (b) help the league group teams in competitive divisions. Practices at Heights; games at Heights and other Northeast Ohio rinks.

Registration for Learn to Play Hockey Program

Early Oct.

Three levels of instruction for beginning players. A good, basic introduction to hockey skills. Helps prepare players who want to play travel hockey for a Heights team in the Cleveland Suburban Hockey League.

Learn to Play Hockey Program

Mid-Oct. to mid-Feb.

Two sessions per week. Free equipment loan with small refundable deposit, excluding stick, skates (which can be rented), and undergarments. All sessions at Heights.

Regular Season, Cleveland Suburban Hockey League (CSHL)

Mid-Oct. to mid-Feb.

For CHHL travel hockey teams. Practices or games approximately twice per week. Skills instruction once per week. Practices at Heights; games at Heights and other rinks in Northeast Ohio. One or two weekend tournaments per year.

Raymond A. Robinson Memorial Tournament

Mid-Jan.

Three-day tournament hosted at Heights by CHHL with teams in all divisions. Exhibition game for Learn to Play participants. Martin Luther King Day weekend.

Registration for Spring Hockey

Late Jan. to early Feb.

A good time for Learn to Play Hockey 3 graduates to start playing full-ice games, and for current Travel Hockey players to continue improving. Less intensive than regular season hockey. More focussed on development of skills.

Postseason Games, Cleveland Suburban Hockey League (CSHL)

Mid Feb. to late Feb.

Spring Hockey Season

Early Mar. to late Apr.

Approximately one practice and one or two games per week. Practices at Heights; games at one or more East Side rinks.

Summer Pickup Hockey

June to mid-Aug.

Weekly one-hour sessions at Heights. Informal (no coaching). Sessions grouped by age. Players wear full gear. Parents supervise.
