

In order to promote the principles of sportsmanship, discipline and mutual respect among players, coaches and spectators, EGBA has established this "Code of Conduct."

Players

- Display good sportsmanship at all times
- Listen to and follow the direction of coaches
- Do not use abusive or profane language
- Do not question an official's call
- Play team basketball and involve all teammates in the game

Coaches

- Treat all players and opponents with respect
- Provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive
- Discipline those on the team who display un-sportsman like conduct
- Respect the judgment and interpretation of the rules by the officials
- Be a positive role model

Spectators

- Attempt to understand and be informed of the game rules.
- Applaud positive performance for all competitors
- Do not heckle, jeer or distract players
- Do not question an official's call
- Do not use profane or obnoxious language or behavior
- Respect the judgment and strategy of the coach and do not criticize players

The Code of Conduct shall govern the actions of players, coaches and spectators. The Code is intended to provide behavioral guidance and establish expectations for all involved. It does not address every conceivable situation. Accordingly, the EGBA Board retains absolute authority to discipline players, coaches and spectators from EGBA activities for violations of the Code. Discipline may include suspension from house and/or travel games and possible expulsion from the league for repeated or flagrant violations.
