



## 2018 MARS YOUTH LACROSSE EQUIPMENT MEMO

Boys are required to have a **stick and a full complement of equipment: helmet (for customizable helmets all navy blue helmet with athletic gold visor is preferred; younger player adjustable helmets typically come in white), shoulder pads, gloves, arm pads, mouthpiece, cup and soccer or football shoes.** Rib pads are recommended. Some helmets can be used as your son grows as they are adjustable. Equipment can be purchased locally or on-line. Below is a list of local stores and websites where equipment can be purchased.
