



CONSENT FORM

MindGame has been contracted by your team to provide concussion education and assist with baseline testing for this sports season. Part of this process is to obtain a neurocognitive "baseline" for all participating athletes. The athletes will take a test assessing memory, processing speed, and reaction time. This test is set up on a computer and is similar to a video game. The reason for the baseline is so that if an athlete has a concussion, they can retake the test and the doctors will have something with which to compare the results. This will help the doctors, coaches, and athletic trainers make better decisions about when that athlete is ready to return to play.

By signing below, you agree to allow your athlete to participate in this testing. The test results are stored on a secure server that can only be accessed using a valid login and password. Each healthcare system participating in this program has access to the baseline test results so that post-injury testing can be performed and compared*. You may obtain copies of the test results for healthcare providers not listed by signing a release of information.

The baseline testing results may be made available to the coaches, athletic trainers, and identified concussion champions (if applicable) for each team/school in the following circumstance: 1. A concussion occurs and post-injury testing is compared with baseline testing; 2. If the baseline test is felt to be invalid and the athlete needs to be retested; and 3. If there are concerns about an athlete based on the baseline testing. For example, there was a recent concussion and the athlete has low cognitive scores and a high symptom score.
