Dear Board Members,

Thank you for your recent donation of equipment to Pitch In For Baseball. In accordance with IRS regulations, we acknowledge that no goods or services were received in exchange for your gift.

Since our inaugural year in 2005, Pitch In For Baseball has impacted over 700,000 kids in every state in the U.S. and over 90 countries. Your gift helps make the game of baseball and softball accessible for many children in under resourced communities who otherwise would not have a chance to play.

In 2016, we completed 352 projects in 36 states and 25 countries, helping nearly 55,000 kids play baseball and softball. Some highlights include:

- Disaster Relief: In 2016, major flooding in Houston wiped out all the equipment for three little leagues. Partners such as the MLB Player's Trust, Jose Cruz Jr, Max Stassi, and private donors enabled PIFB to replenish all the gear that was destroyed.
- Northmarq Capital: Funding from NorthMarq Capital made it possible for PIFB to support the needs of Garfield Park Little League's 18 teams in Chicago. A Little League Urban Initiative, Garfield Park ensures that 300 kids get on the field each year.
- Mauricio Dubon: The Honduras native in the Brewers minor league system teamed up with PIFB to get baseball equipment to his native country where soccer is most popular.
- Wilson Sporting Goods: Wilson donated nearly \$50,000 worth of equipment to 25 middle school teams from the south and west sides of Chicago who received the gear, uniforms, and cleats needed to play ball this season.
- Rosebud Boys & Girls Club: PIFB provided the team out of the Sioux Community in South Dakota with gloves, uniform pants, cleats, and other needed equipment to attend an Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament for Native American kids.

For 2017, we have set an ambitious goal to help 100,000 kids play baseball and softball! This is nearly double the number of kids that we help on an annual basis. To see how many kids we have helped throughout the year, visit our website at pifb.org
