



Brockport Soccer Club Fundraising Information

Individual teams will often embark on fundraising efforts to help raise money for their teams to cover costs of tournaments, practice shirts, team bonding activities, and end of year parties, etc. If a team fundraiser is not an activity that has been approved in the past, then it is required to be reviewed by the board. When in doubt, please contact a board member or submit your fundraiser idea to the board for discussion.

Fundraisers that have been approved in the past include:

- Car wash
- Club logo sale (car magnets, window stickers, bumper stickers – basically any item not offered on team web store)
- Raffle of an item/gift card donated by a local business
- Candy bar, candle, cheese, cookie, or other type of food sale
- Team garage sale

Some fundraisers that have NOT been approved include:

- Marketing product through the club email list
- Gambling activities

Note: As of January 2018, regulations concerning 501c3 Non-profit organizations (the Brockport Soccer Club is one of these) have changed to allow for some types of gambling activities (e.g. 50/50 raffles, Superbowl squares, etc.) If a similar fundraiser idea has been rejected in the past, please resubmit in order to see if it may now be allowed.
