

Agenda for May 1, 2012 Club Meeting

Attendance – 7 of 9 board members, 15 of 20 teams

April 3rd meeting minutes accepted unanimously

Continue to enter of game scores into bysa.org and update team profile. Team passwords were reissued to coaches.

Reminder for game cancellation policy & fees. Tricia must be notified 48 hours in advance (by Thursday) of a game cancellation so she can notify referees. If within 48 hours, club has to pay refs and will pass this along to team.

Games are played in cold & rain as long as fields are safe to play on or if referee determines unplayable. This is true for home & away games.

AEDs (Automated External Defibrillator) are installed at all Suffield soccer fields. Anytime someone who is unconscious or exhibiting signs of a heart attack (severe chest pain, difficulty breathing, profuse sweating for no reason), 911 should be called and someone should get the AED. The AED should be opened, turned on and pads applied if the patient stops breathing. The machine will talk them through the rest.
