



### SBLL All-Star Selection Process

1. Managers nominate players from their respective teams to be considered for age appropriate All-Star teams.
2. [Letter of commitment](#) that outlines the time commitment etc. is given to parents of all nominated players.
3. Parent will either **ACCEPT** or **DECLINE** nomination by signing the letter. Accepting the nomination does **NOT** mean their son/daughter has made an All-Star team.
4. All managers of respective divisions will rank all nominated players.
5. Managers set up a time to meet in person after players have been ranked and **COLLECTIVELY** select the first 9 players for each All-Star team.
6. The actual manager of each All-Star team, at his or her discretion, will choose 3- 5 additional nominated players to fill out and complete his or her **FINAL** All-Star roster.
7. Lastly, All-Star players are announced via an All-Star bag being delivered to the players' home plus a list will be posted on the SBLL website.

### **Things to consider**

- a. Time commitment: Daily, early June through mid-late July, potentially late August.

- b. If a tournament (All-Star) team has thirteen (13) or more eligible players in uniform at a game, then every player on a team roster shall participate in each game for a minimum of one (1) at bat. If a tournament (All-Star) team has twelve (12) or fewer eligible players in uniform at a game, then every player on a team shall participate in each game for a minimum of six (6) consecutive defensive outs and bat at least one (1) time.
- c. A Financial commitment of between \$100-\$200 per player will be requested from each All-Star family for uniforms, All-Star Spirit Pack and, at the discretion of the All-Star manager, team outings. Scholarships available.
