Hi everyone. This fall we are going to be offering a new program that we feel will be beneficial to everyone. After talking to a lot of coaches everyone seems to be in the same spot when it comes to fall.. Double Headers on the weekend that really don't offer anything, but families feel they have to play fall because of the word "exposure"

I have been asked to be the state director of a new company called Prep Baseball Report Sponsored by Under Armor. At this point I know most of you know about it and have seen it. This past weekend PBR sponsored a small tournament at Dakota Ridge, and we did a practice run-through on uploading all of the players who played into the PBR player profile system. The feedback we received from coaches, players, and parents was very positive.

Jeff Legault and I have been in discussion in how we can offer this same service for players in the fall, and we came up with the following idea: We are going to have three types of teams: A 2015 Senior Elite Team A 2016/2017 Elite Team, and Regular teams.

We are going to have tryouts for these teams on **July 2nd** at Dakota Ridge. Time TBA.

The Senior Elite team: (\$1400) will practice twice a week at Dakota Ridge and will be entered in "Top Prospect" Game events at Metro (8/17, Adams State 8/23, Labor Day Tournament (Slammers), Runyon tournament against Junior Colleges 9/13, 9/20 Prospect Game events at CSU Pueblo.

Schedule to still be determined: Event at Air Force, Otero, Trinidad

On Waiting List for Arizona Fall Classic (Families will be responsible for travel expenses)

We will know more at end of July if we can do this tournament in October.

16 Players a team.

The Junior Elite Team (\$1400) will practice with the Senior Elite Team twice a week. Participate in the PBR Underclass Games event at Cherry Creek 7/30-7/31 (Some of the tops players in the state have already requested an invite to this event) Participate at Metro, Adams State, CSU Pueblo, and Air Force prospect games events. Slammers Tournament.

16 players a team.

The Regular teams: (\$750) will enter in Alan Dyer's League at Cherokee Trail (18 Games), practice twice a week in an instructional camp type format. There will be an open showcase event in the fall for these players to attend. Time and place still TBA.

What the players receive:

All players will be profiled in PBR..a site that is subscribed to more than 500 colleges, 200 MLB scouts, and is now started up in 17 States: Colorado, Florida, New York, Ohio, Indiana, Tennessee, Kentucky, West Virginia, Virginia, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Missouri, Illinois, Wisconsin, Kansas, Iowa, Michigan.

The above statement is all the "exposure" players will need.

All Players will receive PBR jerseys. Elite Players will receive a different jersey for each event. All players will receive a PBR hat..but in tournaments they should wear their current high school hat with pbr jersey.

We are in the process of looking for a coach for the Senior Elite Team, and Junior Elite team. The regular teams will be coached by your assistants. Myself, Jeff Markle, and Jordan Cantalamessa will be at all practices helping coach, swing fungoes, pitch BP..whatever is needed..not trying to sound more important than anyone..but extra bodies to help run practices/instructional camps.

Players will be responsible for travel costs to places such as Adams State, and Arizona Fall Classic.

If anyone is interested in helping PBR in the future please let me know.

I have attached and made a brochure/schedule/registration..times/places will change..but I believe we can promote this program as what I have written.
