The board went over the finances and determined fund raising activities for the 2014-2015 seasons. The board decided that we would sell Butter Braids, Raffle Tickets, and have a Poker night at the Mirage. The board also agreed to continue providing King Soopers and Safeway cards (individual) as well as continue to sell bricks and ask for sponsors. Because we are a 503C non-profit, the only monies raised that can go towards an individual player are the grocery cards.

We will start selling Butter Braids in December. As of this time, we have not determined if we will continue to sell tickets for Rockies Games (we have not been given a date to play on Coors Field for 2015). The expectation for amount of tickets we need to sell is high and return on investment is so that the players can play a game at Coors Field for an afternoon. Chris Blake will ask for volunteers for all fundraising activities.

Coach Grubestic discussed winter workouts and will have a schedule available after Thanksgiving.

The board discussed the tournament in Arizona and arrangements. Coach Grubestic has connections with regards to hotel and will make arrangements. It will be all inclusive in the Varsity player fees and Coach would like to rent a bus to transport coaches and players, if cost effective. Chad and Chris will check on the cost of renting a bus for the trip to Arizona.

Coach met and talked with the potential seniors players because he wanted them to have in say in the uniforms for the upcoming season. The seniors decided they were good with the uniforms currently in stock; Coach Grubestic expressed that he found uniforms that have never been worn with price tags still on them. He also would like every player to receive a "player pack" (included in the fee when selected for a team) and would probably include a hat, a shirt and a pair of shorts. Coach Grubestic has people that he has ordered equipment from for years and at a price point that is more favorable than JSP and Nike, both of whom he met with their representatives.

Coach Grubestic talked about the Chatfield Chargers website and would like all e-mails to go to him. Any questions or concerns that we receive from parents should be directed to him.

Coach Grubestic will have a summer program separate from Chatfield High School and will invite players from around the area to participate. It will be a traveling team participating in several tournaments and will be called the South Denver Chargers, LLC. He will put out an e-mail with regards to the summer program soon since many people have asked about a summer program.
