

DSLL 2013 BASEBALL ~ DIVISION AA RULES

DIVISION	AGE	RULES
AA Kid Pitch	9	<p>~ LL Rules apply – Local Rules below.</p> <p>~ Volunteer Umpires used.</p> <p>~ LL Pitching Rules will be enforced (see below) – in addition a Player can pitch a maximum of two (2) innings per game.</p> <p>~ Sliding (unless to avoid contact), bunting, leading is <u>not</u> permitted.</p> <p>~ Runners may not advance until a ball is hit.</p> <p>~ No Stealing or Bunting</p> <p>~ Play is over when a ball hit into the outfield is returned to an infielder – runners half way to the next base are awarded that base.</p> <p>~ Each Player must play 4 innings in the field, but no more than 2 innings at a position.</p> <p>~ Outfielders must be placed a reasonable distance from the base paths.</p> <p>~ A continuous batting order will be used.</p> <p>~ Managers are encouraged to rotate players through all positions during season.</p> <p>~ Games are 6 innings, two hour time limit on weekends, 6 run “mercy” rule per inning, games can end in a tie.</p> <p>~ Teams may position 1 coach in the field in addition to a coach umpiring behind the pitcher when an umpire is not available.</p> <p>Batter may not throw their bats. The first occurrence in the season, the batter is given a warning. The batter is automatically out on the second (or more) occurrences. <u>This rule must be monitored and enforced.</u></p> <p>No advances on overthrows to first.</p> <p>Teams are to track and exchange pitch counts each inning for each pitcher.</p>

Little League Pitching Rules ~ 2013

League Age	Pitches allowed per day
9-10	75

If a pitcher reaches the limit allowed in one day while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until the batter is out or the batter reaches base.

- Once a player has pitched 41 or more pitches in the game, he cannot play the position of catcher in that game.

The rest periods required during the 2011 regular season are:

- If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 51-65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 36-50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 21-35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required before pitching again.
