

2012 Most Commonly Misunderstood and Misapplied Little League Rules

- 1. NO Adults Warming up Pitchers NOT Pre-game NOT in bullpen NOT behind dugout NOT between innings- NOT squatting or standing.
- 2. TOURNAMENT Mandatory Play
 - a. Determined at **START** of the game
 - b. 13+ Players: Minimum 1 at bat AND 3 Consecutive Defensive Outs
 - c. 12 or less: Minimum 1 at bat AND 6 Consecutive Defensive Outs
 - d. Subs entering game for 1st time cannot be removed until MP is met.
- 3. Adults in Dugout = 3 (Includes Manager, Coaches, AND Scorekeepers)
 - a. Must be approved Adult on the roster and/or affidavit
- 4. CATCHER REQUIREMENTS
 - a. <u>ALL CATCHERS MUST WEAR A DANGLING THROAT GUARD.</u> <u>ALL</u> helmet/mask combinations are included. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>
 - b. Catcher **MUST** wear Helmet/Mask/Dangler combination when:
 - 1. Warming up Pitchers & Catching Infield or Outfield Practice
 - c. BASEBALL Catchers must wear the **LONG-STYLE Chest Protector** in all BB tournaments played on the 60 ft. diamond.
 - d. BASEBALL catchers must use a catcher's mitt.
- 5. **NO** Jewelry (except medical alert)
 - a. Earrings CANNOT be taped/covered with band-aid
 - b. **NO** "rubber band-type" or other non-metal jewelry
 - c. Medical Alert Jewelry should be taped in place
- 6. **NO ON-DECK BATTER** below the Junior Level. Player may not swing a bat off the field prior to coming onto the field for their time at bat.
- 7. NO Batting Donuts. Bat Sleeves are OK
- 8. Batting Helmets
 - a. **DO NOT** require Facemasks or Chin Straps
 - b. **NO** painted or stickers without permission from helmet manufacturer
- 9. <u>NO</u> Courtesy Runners are permitted Not for pitchers, catchers or any players. Special Pinch Runner Rule 7.14 applies
- 10. Pitchers MAY
 - a. Wear batting glove under fielder's glove. Not white, grey or optic yellow
 - b. Wear sunglasses
 - c. Wear white undershirt, but not long sleeve white undershirt in BB
 - d. NOT wear sweatbands on either arms
 - e. Plate Umpire sole judge if these items are distracting
- 11. Infield Fly Rule applies to ALL Baseball and Softball Tournaments.
- 12. Throwing the bat (unless intentional) is <u>NOT</u> an out. Player should be warned on first offense and then ejected for second offense. Warnings are per player, <u>NOT</u> a team warning.
- 13. There is **NO** Must Slide Rule at **ANY** Base.

- 14. Below the Junior level, Head First Slides are **NOT ALLOWED** (automatic out) when **ADVANCING**. A head first slide is **NOT** a trip, stumble, crawling to the base, touching with the hands before the feet.
- 15. There is **NO** rule for number of batters a pitcher may hit with pitches before he/she has to be removed. Intentionally hitting batters is illegal.
- 16. First base **CAN** be overrun on a walk
- 17. The batter-runner may turn <u>LEFT OR RIGHT</u> after overrunning first base. Only if the Batter-Runner makes an attempt toward second base has he/she lost their "overrun" protection.
- 18. The pitcher's plate (BB) or pitching circle (SB) <u>DOES NOT</u> stop continuous advancement of a base runner. On a walk, the batter-runner may advance beyond first base, if they do not stop, even if the pitcher has the ball on the pitcher's plate (BB) or in the pitching circle (SB).
- 19. It is **LEGAL** to fake a bunt and then swing at a pitch.
- 20. The Hands are **NEVER** part of the Bat.
- 21. If the batter does not pull the bat out of the strike zone while in the bunting position:
 - BASEBALL: IS NOT an Automatic strike
 - SOFTBALL: IS an Automatic Strike
- 22. Pitches that bounce on the ground are <u>NOT</u> dead balls. A batter may swing, hit, foul off, etc. A batter hit by a bouncing pitch <u>IS</u> awarded first base (if the batter does not swing at the pitch).
- 23. <u>DROPPED THIRD STRIKE</u> (Not for 9-10 tournaments) On a called or swinging 3rd strike, Batter becomes a runner <u>IF</u> pitch not caught by the catcher when less than 2 out and 1st base unoccupied at the time of the pitch or with 2 outs.
- 24. Home plate is in <u>FAIR</u> territory. Balls hitting the plate <u>ARE NOT</u> dead. Batter stepping on the plate <u>IS NOT</u> automatically out.
- 25. The batter's box <u>IS NOT</u> a safety zone for the batter. The batter <u>may</u> be called out for Interference although he/she is still in the batter's box.
- 26. **NO AUTOMATIC Intentional Walks** are permitted in Baseball or Softball. Intentional walks are permitted, but require the pitcher to pitch to batter.
- 27. 60 ft Baseball: Non-Wood bats MUST have BPF 1.15 or less printed on bat.
 - Composite bats only bats on the Licensed BPF-ABI list are legal for BB. Should inspect before game if possible.
 - Illegal in game penalty If Batter steps into batter's box and/or before next batter
 - o Batter OUT, or defensive manager can take outcome of play
 - o 1st Offense Base Coach Ejected
 - o 2nd Offense Manager Ejected

28. Protests:

- Playing Rule or Improper Substitution: Before next play or pitch
- Ineligible Pitcher or Mandatory Play: Before Umpires level the field
- Ineligible Player: When facts become known, but before next game
