Rules of Play: 2016 US Lacrosse Youth Rules will be used

U15FC - FULL CHECKING (**FIELD 1 ONLY**)

U15 MOD: MODIFIED CHECKING

U13: MODIFIED CHECKING

U11: NO CHECKING

U19: NO CHECKING and is 7v7 (no goalie)

Game Format

U15 FC: One, 25-min running game - no half time

U15 MOD/U13/U11/U9:

- Two, 15-minute running halves
- One, 2-minute half time. (Teams will switch sides at half time)
- One, 1-minute timeout, per team, per game
- **Mercy Rule-** If a team is leading by 4 or more goals, the opposing team will receive the ball at the center circle (**Does not apply to U15FC or U15 MOD**)
- Unlimited substitutions can be made on the fly at the score/time area
- **Pool Play:** U15, U13, U11, U9 games resulting in TIE will remain a TIE
- **Possession** starts with the team that is listed FIRST on the schedule.
- **Goal to Defend** is selected by the team that is listed SECOND on the schedule.

Playoff Arrangements

- **U15MOD:** Highest ranked team in each pool enters elimination playoffs
- **U15 FC:** Teams ranked 1-4 enter elimination playoffs
- **U13, U11, U9** teams will play round-robin - No Playoffs
- U15 games will be given ranking points as followed: 3=win, 0=loss, 1=Tie
- The First Place U15 team will receive individual awards
- **U15 Playoffs Tie-Breaker Order:** 1.Goals against , 2. Goals for (Limit 10pts) 3. Head to head winner, 4. Coin toss with both coaches present
- Teams will play up to 2, three min "sudden victory", DRAW to start the game, goalie clears on a save. First goal wins and ends game. After the 1st three min overtime, teams will switch sides, after the 2nd three min overtime the game will remain a TIE

Penalties

Yellow Card:

- **1st Card:** 2 min penalty, player is removed from game, player remains near score table, same players/or sub may return after 2 min. Time carries into second half if necessary. Team plays 'man down' for 2 min (U11 and U9 may sub at time of penalty)
- **2nd Card:** For player that has already received a yellow card in that game... REMOVAL FROM REMAINDER OF GAME- team plays 'man down,' remainder of game. No exceptions

Red Card: Player is not permitted to play in the remainder of the tournament. Team will play a 2 min 'man down' and a sub may take the ejected player's place after the 2 min.

Emergency Care

- First Responders will be on site the entire day. If emergency care is needed please go to a scorekeeper and they will radio a First Responder.
- Please bring your own tape and pre-wrap for it will not be supplied

Inclement Weather

This event is rain or shine. Partial cancellation, game suspension, delay and modified schedule may occur due to inclement weather. In this case, games will resume on time and as scheduled. No extension of the day will occur. All notifications will be made using the Phonevite (to Coaches) and Tourney Machine systems to alert players/coaches/team admin.*Parents will only be alerted via Tourney Machine text/email service for those that have signed up to receive team alerts.

Conduct: Zero Tolerance Code of Conduct policy will be in effect. View the WPSLA Code of Conduct at www.WPSLAGirls.com

All coaches have total responsibility for the conduct of their players and spectators at all times. Coaching from the sidelines is permitted provided:

- The tone of the voice is instructive and not derogatory
- Each coach remains on their half of the field, behind the sideline, between the substitution area and the restraining line
- No coach, player or spectator makes derogatory remarks or gestures to the umpires, other coaches, players or spectators
- No coach, players or spectators uses profanity or disruptive behavior in any manner

FANS are NOT permitted on the team(s) sideline - spectators need to go to the opposite side to spectate.

RUDE COMMENTS, COMPLAINTS AND ALL DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR BY PARENTS, PLAYERS, COACHES AND FANS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. MISCONDUCT COULD RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE TOURNAMENT AND GAME SUSPENSION.

Suspended and Terminated Games

If in the opinion of the game Officials, First Responders, or Tournament Director a game must be suspended for any reason the game may be resumed but is subject to being ended not less than 5 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the next game. If a game must be ended due to misconduct of a player, coach or spectator, the offending team may be suspended from further play and forfeits that game and all remaining games.

Injury

Delays of the game due to injury may result in shortened or ended game times. All games must end 5 minutes prior to the start of the next scheduled game on that field. Score keepers at each field can summon the First Responder to your field in case of injury or emergency.

Home Team

- HOME TEAM is to wear their colored (away) jerseys if possible. And bring home jerseys or pinnies
- The team listed closest to the top of the pool will wear their home colors or pinnies if necessary

Disputes

There are no disputes! The Tournament Director or his/her designee will settle all other disputes and the decision made will be final.

Veterans Park Rules

- **PARKING FOR ALL VEHICLES is \$5 - Due upon entry**
- **NO STOPPING to unload**
- **NO PARKING on any grass areas**
- **RV's/Busses must park off-site**
- **NO Pets**
- **NO Grilling or fires of any kind**
- **Teams are encouraged to bring a tent and set up in the designated team tent areas only**
- **Please put trash in appropriate receptacles**
- **Spectators must spectate opposite the team sidelines.**
