

Shamrocks Disciplinary Actions

In the event a player has been reprimanded for an infraction, the director will be notified as soon as possible. A coach reserves the right to sit a player for infractions such as poor language, or poor sportsmanship. Those infractions can be adjudicated and settled by the coach and director on site.

For more serious infractions, such as theft, vandalism, fighting, and blatant disrespect for coaches, referees, and adults, a player may be sent home from practice or tournaments until a formal review of the infractions have been completed. The procedure for these infractions are as follows:

- 1. Coach notifies the parents and director.**
- 2. Director notifies the Cape Fear Lacrosse Association arbitrator.**
- 3. The arbitrator will review the infractions by speaking, emailing, or phone contact with coaches, director, witnesses, and the individual who is at fault.**
- 4. The arbitrator adjudicates the situation, recommends to the board any punishments, and either reinstates or dismisses that player indefinitely.**
- 5. For a player to return to play in future seasons, he must petition the Cape Fear Lacrosse Association board in writing. The petition must contain the following:**
 - a. Explain the situations, date and time that it took place**
 - b. Any coaches, staff, or parents involved**
 - c. Any mitigating circumstances pertaining to the incident**
 - d. What has the player has done to resolve any conflict or deficiency to the incident**
 - e. Current email, and phone number to make contact after the review**
- 6. The Cape Fear Lacrosse Association will review the petition at the next following monthly board meeting. These meetings are held on the first Monday of every month.**
- 7. The board will vote on player reinstatement with no less than 7 voting board members.**
