

Summer 2017 Shamrocks Alternate Policy

Requirements:

- 1. An alternate invite is required to accept the position as an alternate to receive all team correspondence.**
- 2. New alternates are required to purchase a game uniform. Those fees are as follows:
The current cost of that uniform kit \$200.00**
 - (1) Game Jersey**
 - (1) Game Shorts**
 - (1) Custom Shooting Shirt**
 - (1) Holloway Shooting Shirt**
 - (1) Practice Shorts**
 - (1) Practice Pinnie**
 - (3) Pair of Socks**
 - (1) Helmet Wrap**

Participation:

Alternates may

- 1. Participate in all practices with the team if they pay the alternate fee for the uniform kit. Players need to learn offensive and defensive sets associated with the Shamrocks system of play.**
- 2. If an alternate is chosen to participate at a tournament, it is essential for them to practice and know those specific skills associated with his or her team.**
- 3. An alternate must receive an invite from the team coach to travel to a specific tournament. Absolutely no alternate player will be permitted on the team sideline unless he receives a coach's invite.**
- 4. If an alternate is invited to a tournament, the cost to attend the tournament will be determined by that team's tuition and must be paid in full prior to participation. Team Camp Cost is \$550.00 if invited.**
- 5. A coach may call upon an alternate to travel for multiple situations. Here are a few examples, not all inclusive:**
 - a. A primary player is injured.**

- b. A primary player is committed to a college recruitment event.**
- c. A primary player has a serious illness or death in the family and cannot make it.**
- d. A primary player is missing a tournament due to a prior family engagement. i.e. high school graduation, family weddings for example**

If a player is chosen as an alternate, we believe him or her to possess the qualities to achieve a primary position in the future. We do not want these players to get discouraged or lose interest. We want them to stay engaged and playing with other high caliber players. Staying engaged and playing lacrosse will afford them the best opportunities to earn a travel spot at a future tryout.
