

DBOB A Head Coach Overview

- Do you love coaching high school-aged baseball?
- Do you believe sports provide opportunities to compete, learn life lessons *and* have fun?
- Do you want to help strengthen our local baseball program?
- Would you like to practice and play on one of the premier high school fields in Colorado?
- Would you like to lead our top team in two National tournaments in 2016?
- Do you want to coach where there are already established feeder programs?
- Would you like to be part of a program with a strong volunteer base - where you don't have to worry about off-field duties such fundraising, website management, registration forms, etc?

If this sounds like you, read on. You might be a great fit for our DBoB A Head Coaching position.

Summary

In 2015, each of our 4 teams qualified for the Colorado American Legion state tournament at the 15U to 19U age levels. For 2016, we have a strong group of returning players including a deep pipeline of players for the future due to our strong local youth feeder programs (North Boulder Little League and Bison). In addition, we provide host several yearly tournaments with top national competition and exposure to provide a compelling local summer program for our players. In 2016, we'll once again be hosting the Boulder National Invitation Tournament (BNIT) and American Legion Western Regional.

We're looking for a head coach to run our A / 19U team and to oversee our other high school aged summer teams.

Duties

- Time commitment
 - 4 to 6 days per week
 - Late May through early August (50 to 60 games)
 - Some weekday games begin at 5pm and go as late as 11pm
 - Tournaments typically have weekday daytime games
 - 1 or 2 out-of-town tournaments (travel & lodging paid by DBOB)
- Select team assistant coaching staff (with Director of Baseball Operations approval)
- Roster selection for all teams (Director of Baseball Operations approves all summer team rosters before rosters are posted / communicated.)

Diamond Baseball of Boulder (DBoB) Summer Baseball Positions

- Run tryouts
- Work with Director of Baseball Operations to cancel/postpone/reschedule games
- Contact umpires for cancellations and daily schedule changes
- Work with Director of Baseball Operations on all out of town tournaments/games
- Establish expectations for players, parents and assistant coaches
- Establish regular and reliable communication with players and parents
- Post-game field duties for home games (depending on City of Boulder requirements)
 - Prepare field for next game/day
 - Dump trash/recycle bins into dumpster
 - Clean dugouts
 - Lock up field if last game of day
- Communicate game score updates to local press -- Daily Camera and BOCO preps
- Contact Director of Baseball Operations to restock supplies (chalk, diamond dry, clay).

Skills & Experience

- At least 5 years baseball coaching experience
- At least 3 years high school baseball coaching experience
- Positive Coaching Alliance trained and demonstrated support of PCA values
- Must pass background check

Salary
