MINOR LEAGUE TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS 2018

RULE HIGHLIGHTS

1. Little League Baseball Rules 2018 are in place for this Tournament. Regular Season Rules apply.

- Continuous batting order
- Unlimited substitutions
- Unlimited steals
- No time limit
- No dropped 3rd strike
- No Infield Fly
- No Special Pinch Runner
- Mercy-10 after 4

2. Only Players on the Official Team Roster (with proper mid-season changes, if any) of the League Championship Team are eligible.

EXCEPTIONS:

- A.) In an event that a team can field only nine (9) players, then a non-roster player (officially registered to play the league's minor league division) may be added for the purpose of playing **ONLY IF THERE IS AN INJURY**. This additional player may NOT be a member of any National Tournament (All Star) Team.
- B.) In the event that a team cannot field nine (9) players from the Official Team Roster, then enough non-roster players may be added to the team, to bring the total to ten (10). One of these non-roster players will be designated as the "INJURY REPLACEMENT" and the rest of the non-roster players may not be a member of any National Tournament (All Star) Team.
- C.) **If** at any time during the tournament a roster player is available to play, his appearance supersedes any non-roster player previously appearing.
- D.) A non-roster player may **NOT PITCH or CATCH!**
- E.) 12 year old players are NOT eligible to play in this Tournament without **PRIOR** approval from the Tournament Director and they shall not pitch or catch.

3. Regular season pitching rules are in effect as they would apply for that particular age of the player. All regular season rules apply.

4. There will be a Ten (10) run rule in effect for all games (Official Game is 3 1/2- 4 Innings for Ten Run Rule or Rain).

MacRobbie Minor League Tournament Procedures

Schedule: Any changes necessitated by weather or conflicts with district all-star games will be made by the tournament committee. This may necessitate the move of some games to other fields within the Nanuet complex. Please arrive at least 30 prior to the start of your game. If games end early, the next game may start early. Please check-in with the announcer's booth upon arrival.

Managers Meeting: We will have a managers meeting at 7:00pm on June 14 at Wilhelm Field at Lake Nanuet complex to discuss rules and rosters, etc.

Infield practice: Teams for the first scheduled game of the day may have infield practice as follows: Home team from 25 minutes prior to game time to 15 minutes prior. Visiting team may have infield practice from 15 minutes prior to 5 minutes prior. However, if the field crew is still working on the field, teams will wait and both teams will have infield practice shortened accordingly.

Infield practice after a previous game: If games are running late, we will announce the starting time of the following game immediately after the last out of the prior game. There will usually be about 15-20 minutes between games. In this case, infield practice may be shortened or eliminated altogether, depending on the work needed to be done by the field crew.

Lineups/Changes: All lineups should be given to the official scorer at least five minutes prior to game time. All changes must be reported to the official scorer. Once a change has been reported to the official scorer it cannot be changed (unless it is an illegal substitution). Once a player takes part in the game, the change will be considered an official change. Official scorers may interrupt the game to make notice of illegal substitutions or illegal pitchers, but not batting out of order. The manager is ultimately responsible for abiding by all substitution rules. The age of the pitcher **MUST** be announced to the official scorer and the opposing manager.

Pitch Counts: Managers should verify pitch counts with the tournament committee each half inning.

Coin Toss: The coin toss for home team will be done in the main announcer's booth. Managers should check in as soon as they arrive, when both managers are present, the coin toss will take place.

Substitutes: All Substitutes must be announced

Rules Notes: All Regular Season Little League Rules apply. Some rules of note:

- A maximum of 3 Adults in the dugout/field (1 manager and 2 coaches).
- ALL PLAYERS and COACHES **INSIDE** THE DUGOUT! No Adults warming up pitcher.
- No On Deck Batter, No holding bats in the dugout.
- Catcher: Must have Dangling Throat Guard and Long Model Chest Protector, (No Skull Caps)

Tournament Director and Committee has final say in all matters.
