Ejections and Disqualifications

This bulletin is to clarify what is an ejection and what is a disqualification for a player.

Disqualification

A disqualification is when a player has accrued 4 personal fouls OR 5 minutes worth of personal fouls. Once this happens, the player can NOT play for the remainder of the game. He is 'disqualified from the current contest'. It DOES NOT mean he has to sit out the next game.

Ejections

An ejection is when the player has committed a foul that was malicious in intent, has continued to show aggressive and violent play during the game, takes a 'swing' at someone, provokes and/or gets in a fight. It is up to the officials' discretion for 'eject' any player for any of the above reasons.

The consequences of the ejection are: 1.) Is disqualified for the rest of the game and 2.) Cannot play in the next game.

It is the responsibility of the officials to report the ejection complete with team name, player name and jersey number. The report will be filed in Arbiter. Table personnel should note the difference on the score sheet. Indicate 'Disqualified' for fouls or 'Ejection' for an ejection.
