








#### How did your child like the sport of wrestling this year? Pick one answer.





# Including this year, how many years has your child been wrestling, regardless of where you previously lived or the organization you joined? Pick one answer.



# How would you describe your wrestling experience this year during competitions in terms of your win-loss record? Select the most appropriate description as best as you can.









## How many competition meets should the NVWF arrange during the main season between November and February, for any experience level?



### How many competition meets should the NVWF arrange during the off season of spring, summer, and fall, for any experience level?


