

WHISTLEBLOWER POLICY

If any member reasonably believes that some policy, practice, or activity of Marlboro Youth Soccer Association (MYS) is in violation of law, a written complaint must be filed by that member with the President or the Vice President.

It is the intent of MYS to adhere to all laws and regulations that apply to the organization and the underlying purpose of this policy is to support the organization's goal of legal compliance. The support of all members is necessary to achieving compliance with various laws and regulations. A member is protected from retaliation only if the member brings the alleged unlawful activity, policy, or practice to the attention of MYS and provides MYS with a reasonable opportunity to investigate and correct the alleged unlawful activity. The protection described below is only available to members that comply with this requirement.

MYS will not retaliate against a member who in good faith, has made a protest or raised a complaint against some practice of MYS, or of another individual or entity with whom MYS has a business relationship, on the basis of a reasonable belief that the practice is in violation of law, or a clear mandate of public policy.

MYS will not retaliate against members who disclose or threaten to disclose to a member of the Board or a public body, any activity, policy, or practice of MYS that the member reasonably believes is in violation of a law, or a rule, or regulation mandated pursuant to law or is in violation of a clear mandate of public policy concerning the health, safety, welfare, or protection of the environment.
