

# OSLL Code of Conduct

## VOLUNTEERS

At all Little League functions and whenever representing Old Saybrook Little League, all volunteers of Old Saybrook Little League shall conduct themselves in a manner that is beyond reproach, upholding the integrity of the league. All players shall demonstrate and all coaches shall show by example a positive attitude based on the principles of fair play and good sportsmanship, and a respect for the judgment and position of authority of the umpire.

Any player, manager, coach, umpire, or league representative who is involved in a verbal or physical altercation, or an incident of unsportsmanlike conduct at the game or any other Little League activity is subject to disciplinary action by the Old Saybrook Little League Board of Directors.

Old Saybrook Little League Board of Directors shall conduct a hearing on any incident deemed detrimental to the best interests of Old Saybrook Little League. The Board of Directors, by a two-thirds vote of those present at any duly constituted special meeting called for that purpose, shall have the authority to discipline, suspend or terminate any volunteer or member of Old Saybrook Little League.

## SPECTATORS

The standard of behavior established for all volunteers of Old Saybrook Little League is also extended to the family, friends, and spectators attending Old Saybrook Little League games and activities.

Foul or abusive language, physical abuse, or arguments are not tolerated at any time. Behavior not consistent with that set forward in the Code of Conduct will result in persons being asked to leave the playing area. Repeated incidences will be addressed by the Old Saybrook Board of Directors as stated above.
