

SCSA EVENT SECURITY POLICY

To be used during any SCSA tournament events

Adopted January 21, 2015

Keeping our players and spectators safe is our number one goal!

Advance Planning

SCSA staff will have a documented plan in place, designated people who are responsible for monitoring the safety and a qualified person (Tournament Director, Executive Director, President and/or other staff members) to make the decision to create a fun and safe environment.

Monitoring Play

Local Managers and Field Marshals during the tournament will monitor behavior of the players, coaches and parents. Poor and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Radios will be given to all Managers and Field Marshals for quick communication if needed.

Criteria for Suspending a Player, Coach or Parent

Player safety and creating a fun environment is imperative. If a player, coach or parent is acting inappropriate they may be asked to leave the complex. The tournament director will have the final say for suspending, or dismissing anyone. Local police will be on-site to assist with this action.

Parking Plan

Local police will be asked to help with the flow of traffic to assure a safe and friendly environment.
